OUR PRIORITY: Player safety and wellbeing.
No jewellery. No exceptions.

WHY DO WE HAVE THIS POLICY?



Football is a contact sport.
Jewellery can cause serious injury to the wearer or another player.



Rings, earrings, necklaces, bracelets and other items can catch, pull or break during play.



Even small items can cause cuts, lacerations, bruising or worse.



The FA strongly advises that jewellery is removed for both training and matches.



We have a responsibility to protect every player and promote a safe environment for all.

OUR POLICY

From the start of the 2026/27 season:

NO JEWELLERY is allowed to be worn during:



MATCHES



TRAINING



WARM-UPS



TOURNAMENTS

This includes:

- ✓ Rings (including wedding rings)
- ✓ Earrings (studs or hoops)
- ✓ Necklaces and chains
- ✓ Bracelets and wristbands
- ✓ Any other jewellery or items that may cause injury



**No taping.
No covering.
No exceptions.**

Jewellery must be removed before the player takes part.

COACHES' RESPONSIBILITIES



Check players before every session and match.



Ask players to remove any jewellery.



Players will not take part if they are wearing jewellery.



This policy is applied consistently across all youth teams.

Earrings must be removed for training and matches. We recommend waiting until the piercing has fully healed before returning to wear.
